1. Pick up “**Handbook of Peritoneal Dialysis**” by Steven Guest, MD – to be supplied by Division of Nephrology. On the first day of the rotation (Monday afternoon at 1pm), Dr. Uribarri or Dr. Sharma will arrange for the rotating fellow watch **educational videos on peritoneal dialysis (PD) and home hemodialysis (HHD)** similar to the ones the patients are shown
2. Fellows to be scheduled for 1-2 week block rotations on Amion (sick days and switches only for urgent issues)
3. PD and HHD clinic patients are scheduled for **monthly visits** on Mondays 8am-12pm and Thursdays 8am-4pm. Patients to be assigned to nephrology fellows by Dr. Uribarri and Dr. Sharma as the patients arrive
4. Fellows to see and observe both PD and HHD patients for their support visits when they are scheduled throughout the week.
5. Attend the **weekly** PD/HHD meeting in the dialysis conference room on **Mondays** 3pm-4pm and the **bi-weekly** “Lunch & Learn” conference on **Thursdays** from 12pm-1pm (ask Dr. Uribarri and Dr. Sharma if it is scheduled the week that you are on)
6. Fellow to **observe at least 2 PD catheter insertions** during their fellowship (Dr Uribarri and Dr. Sharma to coordinate with Dr. Benvenisty at Mount Sinai or Dr. Spinowitz at American Access)
7. **Home dialysis fellow** to have a **1-on-1 teaching session** with the rotating fellow twice a week – **Tuesday afternoon** and **Friday morning**
